- humility is inflicted (humiliation)

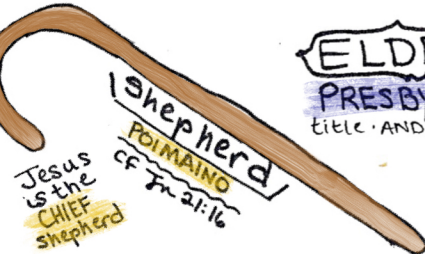
In CHRISTIANITY...

- humility is chosen

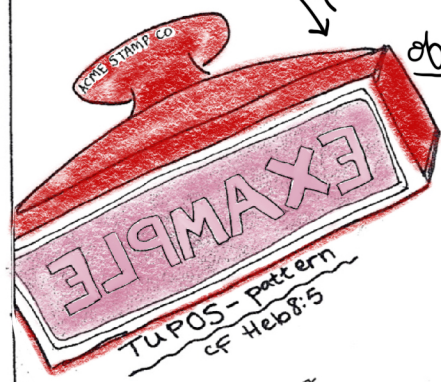
Describe a Christian in one word...
